

Privacy Statement

Acknowledgement and acceptance of terms

By accessing <http://www.samp2.com> directly or via web services posted on third party sites, widgets or gadgets for social networks, you acknowledge and fully understand this Privacy Statement, agree to be bound by the terms contained in this Statement, and freely consent to the information collection and use practices described in this Statement. If you do not agree to these terms, please do not access or use this site.

Information entered by the individual users

You provide certain Personally Identifiable Information (PII) to us, either by producing a SAMP2 or if you want to have an account with us. You provide PII to us by any means. We need your email address to inform and distribute the SAMP2 but we also may ask information like name, address or other relevant information. You may also be asked to disclose personal information to us so that we can provide assistance and information to you. For example, such data may be warranted in order to provide online technical support and troubleshooting.

You may also provide certain PII to us regarding third parties. For instance, when you share your SAMP2 with others, you provide and we collect the email addresses of the people with whom you want to share your SAMP2. The above given information may be used for commercial matters.

Participating Third Party Policies

As SAMP2 is offered as a web service the site may contain links to related services or sites which use our services. These third parties may have their own privacy statements that can be viewed on their websites or by contacting these third parties directly. These third parties who participate in our services are encouraged to participate in industry privacy initiatives and to take a responsible attitude towards consumer privacy. However, since we do not have direct control over the policies or practices of third parties, we are not responsible for the privacy practices or contents of those sites. We recommend and encourage that you always review the privacy policies of these third parties before you provide any personal information or complete any transaction with such parties.

Information We Collect and How We Use It

We collect certain information from and about our users three ways: (1) directly from our web server logs, (2) with cookies, and (3) from you, the user. We do not collect information about the specifics of who you are unless you specifically provide it to us.

a. Web Server Logs

When you visit our site, we may track information to administer the site and analyze its usage and information to further optimize our activity. None of this information is personal.

b. Use of Cookies

We use cookies to personalize or enhance your user experience. A cookie is a small text file that is placed on your hard disk by a web page server. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

The type of information that may be stored in a cookie includes non-PII about you, such as a randomly assigned user or session identification number, the country where you are located, and your first name to welcome you back to the site.

We reserve the right to share mail address and aggregated site statistics with third parties, but will not allow other companies to place cookies on our website unless there is a temporary, overriding customer value (such as merging into our Site another site that relies on third-party cookies).

You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies. If you reject cookies by changing your browser settings, then be aware that this will disable the functionality of our Site.

Accessing Web Account Information

We will provide you with the means to ensure that PII that we have on file for you is correct and current. You must update your PII promptly after it changes. You may review this information by sending us an e-mail (info@samp2.com). You may ask to have the information on your account deleted or removed at any time. We will use reasonable efforts to delete your information; however, because we and our web hosting company have backup systems and keep track of past transactions and/or activities, it may be impossible to completely delete your information.

User Communication

We may, from time to time, send you an e-mail with a newsletter regarding our services. Only 3DClip B.V. will send you these newsletters via direct mailings. If you do not want these mailings, you can tell us by sending an email to info@samp2.com.

Security of Information

We will keep your PII secure consistently. Security of your PII is of utmost concern to us. PII, once transmitted to us, will be stored on computers that only selected personnel and contractors have access to via password, and/or on web hosting servers.

Your SAMP2 and user content are limited-access, where access is gained through an obscured URL system. This obscured URL makes it difficult if not impossible for a third party to guess the URL address of your SAMP2 or content without an invitation from you including the relevant URL. However, because the SAMP2 and content are not password-protected, a possibility exists that an unauthorized third party could discover your SAMP2 and/or content. The individual who visits the account which is protected by the individual unique password is solely responsible for the distribution of the specific obscured URL which relates to the SAMP2.
